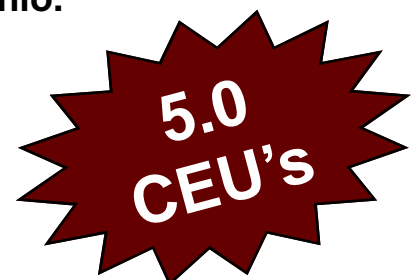
Safety Evaluation of Buildings after Windstorms and Floods

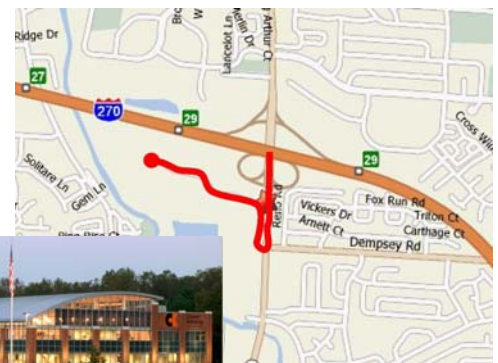

Mr. McCluskey has lectured nationally on emergency response for structural engineers and on precast concrete design.

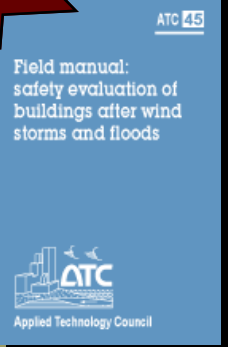
