General Information

The San Francisco Bay Area is known to have a high potential for large, damaging earthquakes. Seismic rehabilitation of one- and two-family dwellings can turn a modest investment into increased safety for dwelling occupants, reduced structural damage, and increased likelihood of dwelling habitability following an earthquake.

This training targets contractors, building department personnel, architects and engineers, to develop a common understanding of vulnerable building configurations, seismic rehabilitation priorities, and available resources for rehabilitation design and installation.

Workshop topics will include:

- Earthquake Effects
- Seismic Rehabilitation Concepts
- Building Code Requirements
- Development of Rehabilitation Plans
- Condition Survey
- Basics of Rehabilitation Construction

Kelly Cobeen, a leading expert in the seismic design and rehabilitation of one and two family dwellings, will instruct this course, which was developed by Ms. Cobeen and the Applied Technology Council.
